## Clinical Significance (Negative AFB Smear)

- A negative AFB smear indicates no detectable acid-fast bacilli in the specimen.
- Does not rule out tuberculosis, particularly in:
  - Early-stage disease
  - Extrapulmonary TB
  - Patients with low bacterial load
- False-negative results may occur due to poor specimen quality or prior antibiotic use.
- Further evaluation using **culture**, **GeneXpert MTB/RIF**, **or radiological assessment** is recommended if TB is clinically suspected.

Repeat testing or additional diagnostic methods may be necessary based on clinical suspicion.
